QUIET TIME

Quiet hours are 11pm — 8am.

OFFICE HOURS

During peak season office hours are 8am — 10pm daily.
September - May office hours are 8am — 9:30 pm (Sun-Thur) and 8am-10:00pm (Fr-Sat).

WASHER/DRYER/ICE

Laundry and ice dispenser are located on the back side of the main lodge and available 24/7 (see the location on the map).

Iron and the ironing board are located at the laundry room as well. Bring it back after using, please.

VENDING MACHINE

Vending machine is located on the back side of the main lodge and available 24/7.

WIFI

Log in - the number of your room / any unit number with the strongest connection to you.

PARKING

Every unit has its own designated parking stall with the number on it. See yours on the map provided by the Front Desk. If you have an additional vehicle, you can park it on the street or contact Front Desk for assistance.

NON-SMOKING ROOM

All units, outdoor patios areas and balconies are non-smoking. Please, use designated smoking areas marked on the map provided by the Front Desk.

DOOR LOCKS AUTOMATICALLY

Make sure you always have the keys with you when leaving the unit as door locks automatically.

RECYCLING

Use the blue recycling bin (for bottles, beverage cans, plastic items, cardboard).

TRASH BINS

For additional garbage use the bin by #19 or #44. Do not leave trash bags outside as it may attract the wildlife, especially birds.

HOUSEKEEPING SERVICE

We provide daily housekeeping service between 9 am - 5 pm. It includes vacuuming, making beds if there are no private items on top, taking the trash out, changing bathroom/kitchen towels, providing bath ware and kitchen supplies.

CHECKING OUT PROCEDURE

Check out before 11 am. Use the key drop box outside of the reception entrance if you check out before 8 am and we will send the receipt to your email. Make sure you have all your belongings with you. If you booked through 3rd party agency - request the receipt from your agent.

DOGS POLICY

Bear Hill Lodge welcomes you and your pet on our property. For an additional \$25.00 + tax per night, we are happy to accommodate your furry friend in one of our pet friendly room.

We believe that your beloved pet should also come along for the fun!

However we follow a strict pet policy:

My dog(s) will be leashed in the all areas of the property.

I do not leave my dog(s) tied up and unaccompanied outside the room.

That dog(s) will not be bathed in the hotel room.

That dog(s) are not allowed on furniture or the bed.

That disturbances such as barking must be curtailed to ensure other guests are not inconvenienced. If loss of revenue results I will be responsible for reimbursement.

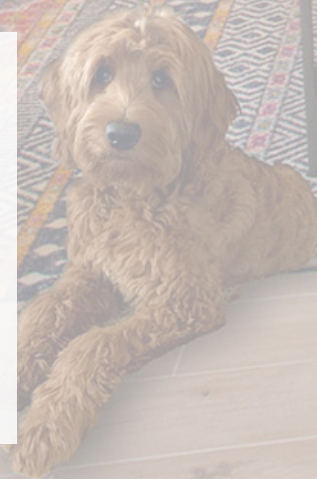
That I am responsible for cleaning up after my dog(s) on the property and in the neighbourhood.

I assume full responsibility for any damage and/or repairs other than normal wear and tear that may occur.

Hotel Management reserves the right for perform room inspections during the stay.

OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

The only place that your dog may be off-leash (though s/he must be still supervised and well-behaved) is in Jasper's fully fenced off-leash dog park. It is located on the other side of the train tracks from downtown Jasper, by the intersection of Sleepy Hollow Road and Hazel Ave.

PARKING IN TOWN

All visitors to Jasper National Park are required to have a valid National Park Pass, regardless of the mode of travel. Park passes can be purchased online, at the park gates if driving to the park, or in person at the Visitor Center in downtown Jasper.

Paid Parking is in effect from May 1 until October 31 annually.

The 2026 rates are \$7.00 an hour on-street or \$28 a day in parking lots. There are three ways to pay:

Scan the QR code on signs (no app download required)

Use a payment kiosk

Download the HotSpot app.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

There are four ways to pay:

- Purchase passes through the HotSpot app.
- Purchase single-use tickets or day passes at the payment kiosk located across from the Hub.
- Transit drivers will accept cash payments for single rides (\$2.50). Exact change & Canadian currency required when paying with cash.

• Purchase single-use, 10 use, and month passes from the front desk at the Jasper Activity Centre.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT FIRE SEASON

In case of forest fire you will be informed of potential evacuations as early as possible. You must take the initiative to stay informed and aware. Evacuation routes, timing and affected areas will change depending on the situation. Evacuation zones may be specified, but the event of a large wildfire, a community-wide evacuation is more likely to happen.

Keep a full tank of gas in your vehicle at all times.

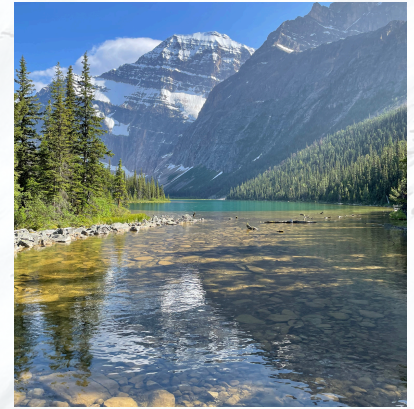

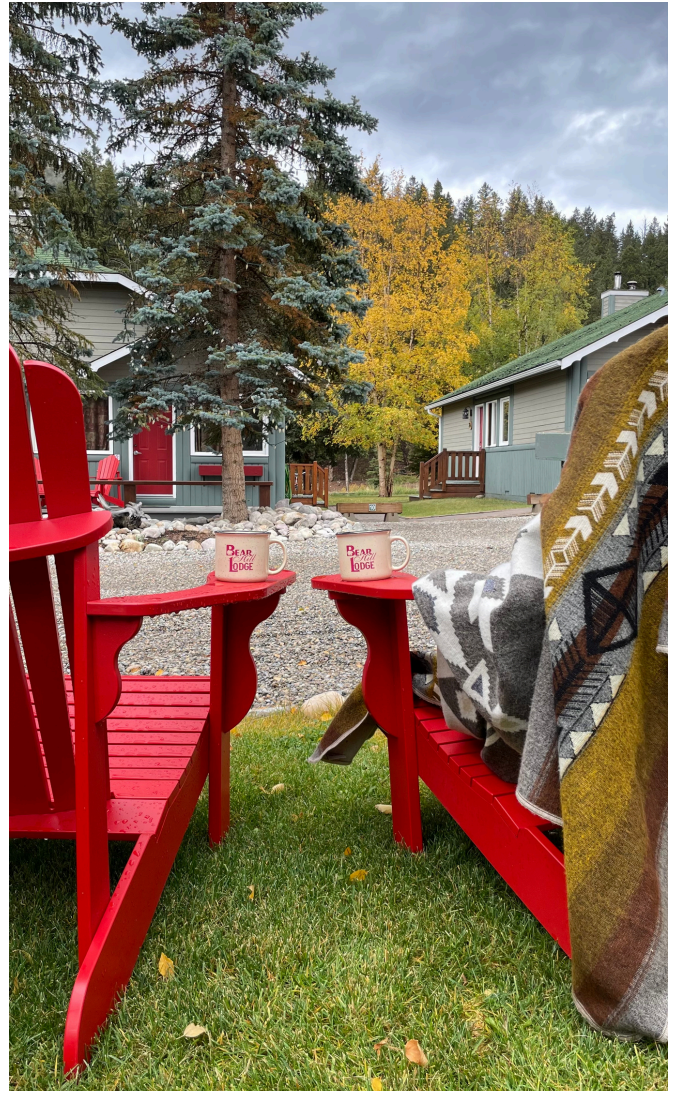
